Site Investigation and Interpretative Report

CGL provided input regarding ground conditions into the Environmental Impact Assessment for the proposed redevelopment of a school in Chelsea.

As part of the commission, **CGL** undertook a desk study and detailed ground investigation comprising boreholes and window sampler holes.

This work was also supplemented by a number of hand dug pits to expose and inspect the existing foundations of existing buildings on and adjacent to the site. A specific excavation was also made for archaeological assessment, by MoLAS.

Together with the site investigation, **CGL** provided detailed geotechnical recommendations with respect to the complex construction of a proposed two storey basement below the existing structure.

All of the site works were carried out whilst the school was occupied. Risk assessments were carried out and agreed with the headmaster in advance and the working areas were securely fenced off throughout the works to protect the pupils. In accordance with the CDM Regulations, the works required a Planning Supervisor, which was also supplied by **CGL**.
