Geotechnical and Geoenvironmental Site Investigation

Prior to the installation of a new sewer Dean and Dyball Construction appointed **CGL** to undertake a site investigation to assess the ground conditions. **CGL** also carried out a classification of the arisings for waste disposal purposes.

The site investigation was targeted along the proposed alignment of a new section of sewer and comprised a series of window sampler boreholes.

The site was formerly an active gas works so there was potential for areas of contamination; current use of the site comprises housing and an active gas holder.

The past and present land uses of the site led to close liaison with the client and involved the review of extensive service plans. This, coupled with a service detection company, allowed service locations to be identified and traced.

Chemical analyses of samples were undertaken as part of the ground assessment and enabled **CGL** to advise the client on waste classification of the arisings.
