Geoenvironmental Advice for Development of an Infilled Quarry

Linden Homes has transformed a disused quarry near Redhill, Surrey into a waterside village including 500 new homes.

Watercolour, as the development is known, provides a series of one and two bedroom apartments as well as two, three and four bedroom houses.

The site was formerly the Holmethorpe Sand Quarry and subsequently an uncontrolled landfill.

CGL has been working independently on behalf of both the local council and the developer and their project team with regard to groundworks, landfill gas assessment, building protection and contaminated land remediation strategy, including the appropriate material specifications for imported materials.

The site also contains a canal, stream, reed beds and two lagoons on the southern edge of the site which have been retained as a wildlife sanctuary.

Once complete the 'Watercolour' site will comprise housing and flats with private gardens and communal open space as well as leisure facilities, shops as well as social and amenity services.
