### Contamination Remediation and Waste Advice

**CGL** was appointed by Kier Southern Ltd to work with the delivery team for the 50m Olympic size swimming pool that is to be opened in early 2009 in readiness for the London Olympics. The Mountbatten Centre with the new swimming pool will be a host site for a major Olympic team in 2012.

**CGL** reviewed existing information supplied by Portsmouth City Council and worked with Kier to optimise remediation and waste disposal requirements on this £16m design and build scheme.

Historically the site lay near a former gas works and close to naval ship breaking yards which lay on the edge of Portsmouth Harbour.

**CGL** undertook additional investigation to delineate areas of potential contamination, verification visits for gas protection measures and the restored landscaping.

In addition, advice was provided on disposal of groundwater encountered within foundations

Verification visits were undertaken in liaison with the construction team to inspect formations where contamination was suspected, gas membrane installations and landscaping details. These will be reported in due course.
