Input to Environmental Statement

Nearly 300 hectares of agricultural land north of Portsmouth was planned for development into a mixture of housing, industrial, commercial and recreational use.

CGL worked along side planning consultants Mayer Brown to examine the geoenvironmental impact of the planned development.

CGL co-ordinated an initial investigation to assess the site's suitability for sustainable urban drainage systems, and to provide indicative foundation requirements.

The extensive investigation required consultation with landowners and tenant farmers together with Unexploded Ordnance contractors.

As part of the contribution to the EIA the work involved the assessment of the impact of the creation of a future cemetery on part of the site. Work on this development is ongoing through the planning stages.

A specific requirement for this site was a hydrogeological risk assessment for a new cemetery which was carried out in accordance with EA guidance P223 Pollution Potential of Cemeteries.

CGL have carried out subsequent targeted site investigation and produced discovery strategies.
